



CONTACT LENS FEE POLICY

By FCLCA law, it is required that all contact wearers are seen every year for a contact lens examination. If you are a new patient to our office, we will need a copy of the prescription for the lenses you are currently wearing. If you do not have a current contact lens prescription and your contact lenses at the time of your appointment you will be considered a new fit, and will have to schedule a separate appointment with our contact lens specialist. Existing patients renewing their current prescription will be charged a \$50 contact lens fitting fee. New patients and/or existing patients that require a different or more complex contact lenses will need to be fitted by our contact specialist. Fees range from \$75-\$125 depending on lens type. This charge is in addition to the cost of the comprehensive exams and is not covered by insurance. Due to our contract with Medicaid, we are unable to fit or sell contacts to Medicaid Patients.

The fitting fee with our contact specialist, which includes follow-up care within the first 60 days, is determined by the type of lenses prescribed, the difficulty of the fit, and whether or not the patient is a first time contact lens wearer. **THIS FEE IS NON REFUNDABLE AND DUE AT THE TIME OF SERVICE.** Lens options and prices can be discussed in detail once the initial examination is completed.

The fitting fee includes:

- The contact lens fitting
- Trial lenses
- Follow-up visits within 60 days
- Trial Lens change if necessary

The fitting does NOT include:

- Contact lenses (prices vary depending on type of lens prescribed)
- Comprehensive Eye Exam
- Medical visits not directly related to contact lens wear (such as infection)
- Contact lens check after the initial 60 days

Payment

Fees for the contact lens fitting or annual contact lens exam are due at the time of service. Full payment is required for contact lenses ordered thru Advanced Eye Physicians. Contact orders will not be processed until they are paid in full. We accept cash, checks, Visa, MasterCard and American Express. After the initial fit we will gladly order contact lenses over the phone with a credit card as long as the prescription is valid.

Contacts ordered take approximately 5-7 days to arrive. Please keep in mind that complex and specialty lenses may have longer delivery times.

Patients who order a year supply of contacts within one month of their contact lens exam are eligible for reduced pricing on contacts. (price savings vary depending on the type of lenses)

There are no refunds on contact lens orders or for exam services.
